

PRE-LOADED Non-Lethal Weapons Instructor

This 2-day (16 hours) program is designed for agencies to train and certify departmental Instructors in Non-Lethal Technology for officers in law enforcement or correctional agencies. The first part

of this training is completed on-line through Northeast Wisconsin Technical College (NWTC) in Green Bay, WI. This course was designed to enhance the agencies in the manufacture's use, and tactical applications of the Air Launchers, Chemical Aerosol Projectors, and Chemical Munitions, Specialty Impact Munitions, and Distraction Devices.
