



Correctional Emergency Response Team Training “CERT”

This 4.5-day (40 hours) agency instructor level certification program is designed for agencies to train and certify correctional officer as “INSTRUCTORS” in Disturbance Control Tactics for jails and camps, and prisons. This course was designed to enhance the agencies in the selection deployment and maintenance of a Riot Response Squad to increase officer safety and introduce the New Mini-Team concept. **This is a physically demanding program! Students are issued 3 BASIC INSTRUCTOR certifications – Chemical Aerosol Projectors, Impact Weapons and CERT**
