



Protective Gear Simulator Instructor Development

This 1.5-day (12 hours) course is a “sequel” to the Protective Gear 101 Instructor course. It can be offered immediately following the 101 class or as a stand-alone course. It focuses on instructor and scenario development issues and liability concerns when using **ANY training suit** gear during defensive tactics training. Focusing on topics like safety coaches, practical exercises, dynamic moment, and force on target, instructor survival tactics, and scenario based training, weapon control and safety issued for using training firearms and projectiles, sanitation and health issued and much more! **Recommended student attend the Protective Gear 101 Instructor program!**

Topics covered in the program include:

- Acclimatization of suits
- The purpose of using various protection levels
- Instructor and Student Suit Orientation Drills
- Movement, Falling, Blunt trauma Drills
- How to enhance visual and auditory aids for students
- Enhanced configuration equipment
- Student Evaluation and documentation
- Multiple officer control drills
- Training with marking projectiles
- Using Less Lethal training munitions
- Weapons transitions
- Documentation & medical issues
- Safety Issues and concerns
