



# **RRB Basic Instructor Course**

This 1.5-day (12 hours) Basic Agency Level Instructor certification program is designed for agencies to train and certify departmental personnel as Basic Instructors in a complete use of force continuum program focusing on handling and documentation of the Rapid Rotation

Baton, to include instructor development concepts, evaluating students, conducting drills for safe scenario testing, officer survival tactics, RRB transition drills, use of force issues, medical issues and legal liability specifically designed for law enforcement, and corrections. Upon successful completion you will receive a certification that will allow you to certify others to carry and deploy the RRB! Valid for three years upon completion.

**Pre-Requisite- Must have attended the RRB Basic Use Course or another baton Instructor certification**
