



Tactical Instructor Non-Lethal Weapons

- Decontamination of chemical (indoor and outdoor)
- Patrol deployment of non lethal weapons
- Using two person launching teams
- Strategies for deployment of chemical munitions
- Tactical deployment of non lethal weapons and devices
- How to use marking rounds for non lethal weapon training
- Weapons retention tactics for non lethal weapons
