



Squad & Teams Leadership Training for Law Enforcement

This 2.5-day (24 hours) agency instructor level certification program is designed for agencies to train and certify correctional officers as “Squad or Team Leaders” in leading, and commanding Riot Response Personnel and Squad when responding to small or large groups of rioters. This course was designed to instruct leaders in selection of personnel and establishment of standards for these teams and personnel. Focus is on the welfare and moral of their officers and training needed for basic and in-service training, mental conditioning and physical requirements needs to be in a leadership position. We will address and demonstrate the need for protocol procedures for selecting personnel, equipment, and munitions, and various non lethal weapon options. Also address; how to write and issue contingency plans, logistics needed to respond to a disturbance, and protecting departments from costly litigation issues that could arise from these situations.

- How to move and control personnel
- Establish & maintaining response personnel

- Evaluating your personnel
- Conducting site surveys
- Threat assessments for force options
- Training review of personnel
