



Weapons Disarming Instructor

This 2.5-day (24 hours) agency “Advanced Instructor,” level certification program either builds on the basic program or stands alone to develop Defensive Tactics Instructors to upgrade their skills in the use of techniques and tactics for disarming all types of handguns and long guns consisting of but not limited to shotguns, rifles, carbines with and without sling, and edged weapons consisting of but not limited to tactical folders, fix blades, hunting knives, and swords, to include blunt instruments. This course will cover integrated use of force options for tactical situations that develop rapidly in any type of physical encounter. **Learn from experienced instructors with real world experience in field applications. Combines short and long gun, edged weapons and other blunt instruments used to attack police.**

Topics covered in the program include:

- How to develop a “60 Second Survival Rap”
- How to read micro and mini facial expressions
- Limb control techniques and control methods
- Cross trapping and mounting tactics
- How to safety and effectively disarm a handgun
- Control and stabilization tactics
- How to safety and effectively disarm blunt instruments
- Controlling the pace and breathing
- How to safety and effectively disarm a knife and swords
- Disarming tactics for blunt instruments
- Integrated use of force options
- Power locks & grips
- Maintaining your DT program
