This program is conducted in a 3 Basic or 5 day Instructor format and is designed to train and certify departmental Instructors in Counter Ambush Survival Strategies CASS™ which is a complete and comprehensive program conducted in an “**Emotionally Safe and using Performance Driven Instruction,**” focusing on, understanding basic facts of human action and reaction philosophies, addressing the basic principles of ambushes and how they vary from each other, the dynamics of these ambushes; mind set of attackers, weapons and other devices and traps used, how to identify lookouts, select fall back locations, avoid choke points, identify kill zones and the immediate response to winning against these dangerous and deadly attacks. This Individual and Team CASS™ program was developed to assist agencies in how to identify these ambushes and give the officer the right survival mind set and skills to winning against these types of attacks when the odds and the elements of surprise are not in their favor. The 3 day course is designed for using small caliber firearms and the 5 day covers both the issued firearm, precision rifle and shotgun. **This is an emotionally challenging and physically demanding program must be fit for duty and in survival shape to attend.**
