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DIGNITARY PROTECTION – BASIC LEVEL 3

Our Dignitary and Security Protection training is broken down into 3 separate areas to give the individual or team the options of ensuring their own personal or mission success. More detail agenda are provide after initial interview and final training agreement is confirmed.

Basic Level 3

Our Dignitary Protection Team (DPT or Level 3) comprehensive training program focuses on the realities of the job, assignments and team organization into a 6 consecutive day programs to include 2 night training exercises and simulations) and teaches the performance skills necessary to operate effectively and efficiently in a no-nonsense format for deployment in the field or garrison related environments. This course is for teams and organizations preparing for an assignments domestically or internationally or teams needing additional work and fine tuning their own skills prior to new assignments.

Course participants learn the following:

- Building Intelligence and Counter Intelligence strategies
- Conducting route assessments, surveys and selecting danger points
- Establishing team roles and responsibilities
- Conducting surveillance and counter surveillance tactics
- Pre-Planning Strategies for transport of principals and events
- Review of case studies on kidnappings, assassinations and successful and failed protection details
- Understanding Ambush methods and counter ambush tactics
- Surviving the Attack and principal recovery options
- Evacuation Exercises and emergency planning
- Identifying and Responding to Improvised Explosive devices
- Basic Protection Strategies for formations, motorcades
- Basic Defensive Driving Evading Tactics
- Basic Counter-Combative Tactics for Unarmed Attacks
- Live Firearm and weapon course qualifications
- Improvised Weapons (Unconventional Weapons Deployment and Defense)
- Field Proven Tactic and Strategies for Protection and Security Details

Duration: 3 Day – Basic Level – 1
