The STARC™ program is conducted in various terrain, climate and elements in a 1.5- 3-5 day format are designed to train and certify departmental Instructors as Basic Trackers, Locator Specialist or as a Basic Instructor Tracker. This complete and comprehensive program is conducted in an **“Emotionally Safe and using Performance Driven Instruction,”** focusing on, understanding basic facts of human behavior most often not covered in these types of programs, information and intelligence gathering, immediate questions to ask during notification, managing the first 60 seconds, issuing immediate orders for isolation and containment, joint agency strategies, identifying possible ambushes, using field and land navigation skills, shadowing and trailing techniques, orientation exercises, how to initiate fast recovery of target, important elements of a capture, tips for using technology and so much more. Even though we will address some basic field tracking - **this is NOT a wilderness tracking program!** STARC™ is for individuals and small teams to assist agencies in understanding the dangers of tracking as well and will address survival skills needed if captures during the tracking operation. STARC™ will also show how to use known elements of land navigation strategies and area orientation techniques, and the “Human Factor,” for tracking subjects that have either escaped arrest, evaded pursuit, runaway inmates from facilities as well as missing or lost children and adults. These courses were designed to work with or without the use of canine due to their unavailability or other terrain conditions. We will show how you can use technology and other optics to assist in locating your intended target. **STARC™ is emotionally challenging and physical demanding and must be in shape to attend and successfully complete this course.**
